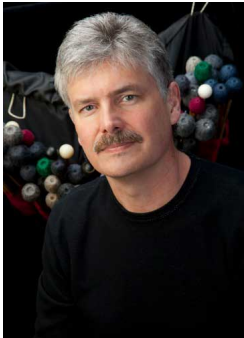


Order in the courtroom! MVM brings the world of electronic effects to the Hopkins County Courthouse
