

Five SS athletes advance from district track

LONGVIEW — It was Texas High taking top team honors for the boys and Pine Tree winning the girls division in 14-A track action held at Pine Tree's Pirate Stadium.

Texas High took the boys title for the fourth consecutive year.

Sulphur Springs was sixth place in both in the boys and girls varsity divisions.

Sulphur Springs will have five athletes representing the school in Class 4A, Region II meet at UT-Arlington on April 25-26.

Madeline Massey will be competing in two events at regional.

Massey won the 1,600 race with a time of 5:31.88 and took second in the 3,200-meter run with a time of 12:28.46.

Chalayah Moore was a district champion in the shot put with a toss of 35-1 3/4.

Chrissalynd Person was second in the long jump with a 16-6 finish.

Two Wildcats advance to regional, Zach Spigner and Barry Stribling.

Spigner had a 15.81 time in the 110-meter hurdles.

Stribling had a slow start and moved into second place with a fine late long jump. Stribling had a 20 feet, 7 1/2 inch jump. First went to Lamarcus Reese of Pine Tree at 20-11.

Jaylon Dugan was fourth in the triple jump, 42-11; Seth Harred took third in the shot put, 43-0.5; Dilllon Carpenter was fourth in discus, 125-7 1/2; Jacob Gatewood took sixth in the 3,200-meter run, with a time of 10:45.38.

For the girls - Mackenzie Moore was third in the 100-meter hurdles, 16.87 and sixth in the 300-meter hurdles, 53.17; Person took sixth in the 200-meter run timed at 27.11. Aijalon Pryor was fourth in the shot, 31-6.5. Destiny Wade was fourth in discus, 109-9.5.
