

Cumby registration for pre-k, kindergarten rescheduled for next week

Cumby Elementary had to postpone its annual pre-kindergarten and kindergarten round-up earlier this month due to the snow and ice storm March 2-3. Cumby pre-k and kindergarten registration has been rescheduled for Tuesday, April 8, at 9 a.m. in the school cafeteria.

In order to register for pre-k, the child must be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1. To register for kindergarten, the child must be 5 on or before Sept. 1. Applicants will be asked to show a birth certificate for each child applying to verify age.

Parents and guardians are asked to bring for each pre-k and kindergarten student registering a Social Security card and up-to-date shot records. Proof of district residency should also be provided as well; tax statements are preferred.

Those signing a child up for pre-k will be required to provide proof of household income.

Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-served basis for pre-k. There are limited spaces so those planning to register a child are encouraged to arrive by the start of registration at 9 a.m. Tuesday, April 8.
